Most recently, the organization bestowed its prestigious award on Barbara Cook, the Broadway and concert artist legend. "We are delighted to bring this program back to Chicago theatergoers," said Missimi. "It is a musical reminder of the wealth of talented artists who claim Chicago as their home."
